

Tella Academy Scholarships



The origin of the project

Tella Academy was created as a natural extension of the **Felice Veneziani Scholarship**, with the aim of making this initiative accessible to a growing number of students in a structured and ongoing way.

Each scholarship is **personalized for the individual** — not a generic contribution, but a tailor-made journey that can truly change the life of the recipient.

The main destinations 2026 will be:

Ireland – Cork, Dublin, Waterford

William - London - London

Spain – Valencia

How we select candidates?

Tella Academy scholarships are intended for deserving, motivated students with limited financial resources.

The selection is managed by the association's team in collaboration with partner schools based on those main criteria:

- Academic performance and a teacher's recommendation letter
- Language level (minimum B1-B2)
- Extracurricular involvement (volunteering, social or cultural activities)
- · Economic and family background

After the pre-selection phase, sponsors may take part in **the final interview** to help choose the candidates most aligned with their values.



How the Scholarships are funded?

Scholarships are financed through three complementary channels:

SPONSORSHIPS FROM COMPANIES OR INDIVIDUALS

HOST ORGANISATIONS AND INTERNATIONAL PARTNERS

MEMBERSHIP FEES AND THE TELLA ACADEMY FUND

SPONSORSHIPS FROM COMPANIES OR INDIVIDUALS

Anyone can sponsor a scholarship in their own name, in the name of their company, or dedicate it to someone special.

The contribution covers the full cost of a **4-week** educational stay abroad, including round-trip flight, language course, full board accommodation (host family or residence), internship, local transport, and on-site support.

Cost of a complete scholarship:

€2.000 per student

(applicable to all main destinations: Ireland, United Kingdom, and Spain)

Each scholarship can support **one or more students**, depending on the sponsor's contribution.

Simply calculate €2,000 per participant to cover the total cost of travel, course, and accommodation.

Sponsors can also:

- Choose the name of the scholarship (eg. Future Leaders Scholarship, in memory of...);
- Brand it, by adding their company logo or a personal message;
- Decide how many students to support, based on theri available budget.

2 HOST ORGANISATIONS AND INTERNATIONAL PARTNERS

Language schools, universities, or international companies can **directly sponsor** one or more scholarships by covering costs locally.

Example: a language school in London, Dublin or Valencia may offer its own scholarship by covering the round-trip flight and providing courses, accommodation, and on-site support for a total value equivalent to €2,000 per student.







3 MEMBERSHIP FEES AND THE TELLA ACADEMY FUND

By registering with the Association as a **promoting member**, you contribute with an annual fee of €250, which goes into the **Tella Academy Scholarship Fund**.

This fund enables the association to directly finance new scholarships in its own name, including for students who are not already sponsored by private individuals or companies.
