Tella Talks è un'attività formativa basata sul dialogo pensata per studenti e studentesse in classe o in altri contesti educativi guidata da un docente o tutor. L'obiettivo è stimolare dialogo, confronto, pensiero critico, collaborazione e consapevolezza personale.

Il docente o tutor svolge un ruolo attivo di facilitazione guidando la conversazione, approfondendo i temi che emergono e la piena autonomia didattica può esprimere il contributo preparando domande aggiuntive anche a tre mesi prima delle carte.

Non esistono risposte giuste o sbagliate: conta il modo in cui si argomenta, si ascolta e si collegano le riflessioni alla vita reale e alla propria esperienza.

Ogni cofanetto Tella Talks contiene 30 carte domande dedicate a un tema specifico, 10 carte da Disper per ampliare e approfondire la discussione, 2 carte Jelly per rendere l'attività più dinamica e coinvolgente, o tre a una carta illustrata e una carta riassuntiva delle domande per facilitare la scelta tra le attività.

How
to play

Tella Talks is a discussion-based learning activity designed for classrooms and other educational settings. Guided by a teacher or tutor, it encourages dialogue, critical thinking, collaboration, and self-awareness through meaningful discussion.

The teacher or tutor acts as a **facilitator**, with the freedom to use their own teaching style and creativity to guide the activity. They are encouraged to explore emerging ideas, adapt the discussion to the group, and ask additional questions beyond those on the cards to deepen reflection and enrich the learning experience.

There are no right or wrong answers. What matters is how ideas are expressed, how others are listened to, and how reflections connect to everyday life and personal experiences.

How it works

in 3 STEPS

CHOOSE A TOPIC ————— 1

Choose one of the available **Tella Talks topics**. Each box is dedicated to a specific topic and also includes a Go Deeper deck to help deepen the discussion. If you only have one box, simply move on to the next step.

DRAW A CARD ————— 2

The teacher or tutor invites a student to draw a card from the Tella Talks deck. The student reads the question aloud and shares their thoughts and ideas.

- **If a Question Card is drawn**, the student answers the question.
- **If a Joker Card is drawn**, the student follows the instructions on the **Joker Card**.

Once they have answered, the teacher or tutor invites another student to draw the next card, and the discussion continues. *Alternatively, the teacher can view and select the question directly from the **Question Summary Card**.*

GO DEEPER (optional) ————— 3

At any time during the activity, the teacher or tutor can use the **Go Deeper deck** to draw a card and explore the topic being discussed in greater depth, encourage further reflection, explore different perspectives, and enrich the discussion.

Choose one of the following options:

FLIPPED CLASSROOM

Become the facilitator (teacher/tutor) and choose who draws the next card and answers the question.

GO DEEPER CARD

Choose any topic, draw a card from the "Go Deeper" deck, and decide whether your classmates or your teacher/tutor will answer it.

YOUR VOICE

Choose a word related to the topic.
Create your own question.
Decide whether your classmates or your teacher/tutor should answer it.
